BATH & SHOWER WASTES — STANDARD FINISHES

Cleaning & Care

Your waste is finished in chrome, brushed brass, black or bronze, matt, gloss or stainless steel — all built for daily bathroom life. A little routine care keeps it looking like new.

Day to day

- ✓ **Wipe dry after each use** — a soft cloth stops water spots and limescale, especially on chrome and gloss.
- ✓ **Clean with warm water and a mild, pH-neutral detergent**, then buff dry with a clean, soft, lint-free cloth.
- ✓ **Brushed & stainless finishes — work along the grain.** Wipe in the direction of the brushing, never in circles, to keep the texture even.

Best avoided

- ✗ **Abrasives** — no scouring pads, abrasive sponges or steel wool; they scratch every finish, and matt and brushed show it most.
- ✗ **Acids, bleach & descalers** — no limescale removers, bleach, ammonia or solvent cleaners; they can pit, dull or discolour the finish.
- ✗ **Metal polishes & “brightening” sprays** — not needed on these finishes, and they can mar coated, matt and brushed surfaces.
- ✗ **Dyed or wet cloths left in contact** — can mark the surface or transfer colour, so don't drape cloths over the waste.

✗ Abrasives · Acids & bleach · Metal polishes
